Beautifully landscaped, designed by Bettler Baldwin and installation by Courtland Paul, the model homes reflect a wealth of luxury features. Massive walls flow from kitchens into living and dining areas, backgrounding huge, custom-styled fireplaces, all-gas kitchens with built-in O'Keefe & Merritt ranges and ovens with Pryne Hood, Pioneer water heaters, Waste King pulverators and many other special features.

There is a choice of three or four bedrooms, or three bedrooms and family room, all with two big luxury baths.
