Track and Field Finale To be Held at El Camino

Local track and field activities will reach a new high during the week of April 29 - May 3, when the cream of this year's junior college cinder stars from Bakersfield to San Diego convene at El Camino college to seek out 1957 Conference track and field finale.

Eight of the top JC track teams in the state, each of which is eager to relieve Los Angeles Valley JC of the team championship captured last spring, will see action.

Present plans call for holding the meet in two sections, a preliminary meet on Tuesday, April 30, which will serve as an elimination event to determine who will compete for the top money in each event on the following Friday.

Valley, the defending titlist, will receive stiff assaults on its attempt to repeat as the conference flag holder from Santa Monica City College, East Los Angeles JC, Harbor, Long Beach City college, San Diego, Bakersfield, and El Camino when these squads converge on the local college's runways.

Individual winners at this meet will be eligible to continue to try their luck against the entire states' best three weeks later, when all the conference champions and their runner-ups vie in the State meet at Modesto's California Relays.

In announcing the site of the league production, Cecil G. Zain, conference commissioner, released no notice of officials who will oversee the event.

Fern-Greenwood Kindergarten Enrollment Told

EC Warriors to Play In Azusa Tournament

After gleaming a couple of conference wins, El Camino college baseballers travel to Azusa this afternoon for the annual baseball tournament sponsored by the Azusa Civitan club. In the first round of play, the Warriors meet the strong Phoenix JC team today at 2:30 p.m.

Caminomen draw a bye in the second round, as they are seeded in the tourney play which continues through Saturday.

The Warriors go into the tournament with one of the weakest won-lost records in years. With hitters continuing their improved stickwork and continued good pitching, however, the tribesmen could provide the tournament upset.

Key to the vastly improved Camino team is slugger Ed Saunders, who is hitting over .450 in conference play and averages two hits per game. One of the strongest batters in the Metro conference, Saunders has tallied five home runs and is leading his team in runs batted in for the season.

A graduate of Gardena High school, Saunders is a sophomore at El Camino. Last year he lead Warrior batters, though working as a pitcher. In the outfield, the team's hit king boasts one of the strongest arms in the conference. In six games, no runner has scored on a ball hit to his field.

Another noted improvement in the Warrior line-up is a fellow graduate of Gardena High, Pitcher Jimmy Lynn. Lynn is improving with every game and gaining confidence. In his last effort, he threw a four-hit job at Santa Monica, beating the Corsairs, 10 to 2.

In his collection of pitches, Jimmy throws a sneaky fast ball, a good sharp breaking curve, a terrific change-up curve, and a change-up fast ball. The five-foot-nine chucker weighs only 150 pounds and he is a determined fighter.

The rest of the Camino team is starting to hit the ball with authority. Every game played is a game in which a lesson is learned and mistakes are not made twice. Top men to watch in the hitting department are left fielder Steve Nicks, shortstop Dave Watt and catcher John Carbray. All are hitting at a solid .300 plus clip and second baseman Dick Weber, center fielder Rich Lindner, third baseman Ralph Hemp and first baseman Skeet Smith are all elosing in fast.

Changes
A couple of changes have been made in the Warrior infield. Dave Watt has been shifted into shortstop and Dick Weber has been inserted in the keystone spot. Ralph Hemp, regular shortstop, has been moved to third base.

In the recent Santa Monica game, every man in the lineup knocked out at least one hit. Running the bases with determination and taking everything they could get, the Warriors seem to find themselves. For the first time this year they came together as a team and worked that way.

The pitching staff is getting stronger with Tom Vanderpool in good condition again after a slight attack of food poisoning. Vanderpool was slated to throw against Santa Monica, but as it turned out it was Jimmy Lynn's day all the way.




