tions at a minimum after 10 p.m.

6. Paint booth operations have been moved to the airport location.

7. Firtex baffles have been placed in all windows in the west walls and all openings permanently closed.

Additional improvements to be made to cut down on noise factors are:

1. Reduce output of public address system immediately.
  2. Seal all remaining cracks, windows, ventilators and other opening in the Elm St. Wall within 3 months and install soundproofing equipment and air conditioning.
  3. Move forming tables 50 feet from the Elm St. Wall within 2 months.
  4. Install sound blankets on the Elm St. Wall and ceiling within the next 45 days.
  5. Cover the roof with a sound deadening mastic within 2 months.
  6. Cover the windows on the east side of the building with firtex within one month.
  7. Install sound traps for the ventilator opening in the south wall within 45 days.
  8. The panel doors facing the interior yard will be covered with firtex within 30 days.
  9. Paper housing for the cycle change will be installed within 60 days.
- Beautification to the Carson plant will be made within the next 2 months, according to the letter. Improvements proposed are to:

1. Repaint the west and south walls of the Elm St. building.
  2. Cover the metal portions of the roof with a mastic properly colored.
  3. Place tree planters at the property line of the parking lot.
  4. Plant ornamental shrubs along the Elm st. side of the Elm st. building.
- Walter Wittanin, property owner near the plant, again raised objection to granting Longren any extension of time and pointed out that heavy manufacturing should not be allowed since the variance is for light manufacturing.
- A few neighbors spoke on behalf of Longren and stated emphatically that there "wasn't any noise" and that they were not "annoyed by the plant."
