

### City Fears Delays In Freeway

No further changes in the proposed route of the San Diego Freeway in this area have been asked in a resolution submitted to state and county authorities by the Torrance City Council. "Any change in plans will further delay the construction of the freeway," the resolution stated. It also pointed out that the freeway is urgently needed to relieve traffic congestion in this area. Organizations in Lawndale and Lennox have tried to have the route moved eastward.

### Area Board Endorses Proposition

The Welfare Federation board of the Harbor Area (Community Chest) today stood with other community-spirited local organizations in endorsement of Proposition B, \$39 million bond issue of the City department of recreation and parks.

Of this amount \$450,000 would go to improve Harbor Park; \$400,000 to Wilmington; \$300,000 to Harbor City; \$300,000 to San Pedro Hilltop Park Development and \$50,000 to Leland Park, according to Ernest Ehrke, Harbor District director of the department who spoke in behalf of the bond issue.

The board, with Jay Albert Robinson as chairman, pledged full support to formation of a Harbor Area Advisory committee by the Visiting Nurse Association of Los Angeles, Harbor branch, a Community Chest-aided agency.

The board members, in discussion, noted increasing need for visiting nurse services as provided by VNA, because of curtailed hospital beds in the Harbor area. Mrs. A. W. Warnock, Harbor member of the board of directors of the VNA, pointed out that during the 1956-57 fiscal year, 9417 visits were made to 716 patients in the Harbor area alone. Miss Aubrey Frank was introduced as new harbor VNA supervisor.

Mrs. Warnock also explained that there is a non-profit fee for those financially able to pay whereas free or part-pay service is available through funds provided through the Los Angeles Community Chest for those not able to pay full fee. Harbor offices are at 1841 Torrance Ave.

### Baby Strollers For Shoppers




