ENLISTMENT DEADLINE ANNOUNCE

Public Information Officer Nap Bilodeau announced this week that June 23 will be the deadline for enlistment in local Company "E" 132nd Armored Engineer battalion before it proceeds to Camp Roberts for two weeks of active training in August.

The army, 2505 Cabrillo ave., will be opened all day on the 23rd and all potential enlistees will have an opportunity to see how the men of the unit actually train on a Sunday multiple drill.

M/Sgt. John L. Garcia, who is company 1st Sgt., will be on hand from 7:30 a.m.-5 p.m. to answer all questions pertaining to enlistment and the new draft

laws recently enacted by Congress. Bilodeau also stated that only 11 vacancies for privates exist and that 10 vacancies for former NCO's are still open.

Commanding Officer Capt. Douglas Horlander can also be contacted regarding the two openings for former engineer officers.

M/Sgt. Garcia has over 13 years of military service. He entered the Army in 1943 and served with the 77th Infantry Division in the Pacific for over two years. He saw considerable action while overseas and has a number of decorations. He was discharged as a Tech. Sgt. in 1946 and joined the National Guard as unit administrator in San Pedro. He was transferred to the local unit when it was organized in 1954.
