Public Hearing

The Board ordered its clerk, Gordon Nesvig, to advertise the county's intention to purchase the property from its owners, Dominguez Estates Co. The matter is set for public hearing on August 8.

The site is bounded on the North by 189th St., on the West by Main St., on the East by Avalon Blvd. and on the South by the Dominguez Channel and Edison company right-of-way.

According to Chace, improvements to be constructed in a five-year development program include the 6500-yard, 18-hole course, complete clubhouse, driving range and putting green facilities.

Also slated for construction is an extensive picnic area, child play areas and a giant athletic field having three ball diamonds with an overlying football-soccer field. The field will also have facilities for night softball play.

The ambitious five-year program anticipates also the construction of a swimming pool and sport-atorium having multi-purpose rooms for community use as well as gymnasium facilities for industrial and league competition.

First priority for construction, according to Norman Johnson, director of the County's Parks and Recreation Dept., will be awarded to the golf course and clubhouse facilities, because these are revenue producing and will help finance the remainder of the project.

Plans and specifications for the course will be prepared during the 1957-58 fiscal year. It is hoped that construction of the golf course might begin on July 1, 1958.

on the fact that the local school district's proposed new tax rate is considerably higher than that proposed by Los Angeles.

The local district is planning to charge \$3.09 (plus 56 cents by El Camino college) as opposed to \$2.76 being considered by Los Angeles city.

Sam Waldrip, assistant superintendent, business, explained that the reason the local district is higher than Los Angeles is because Los Angeles has a higher assessed valuation and is wealthier, as a result.

"Los Angeles has twice the wealth per pupil that Torrance has," he said. "For instance, on a 25 cents override tax, they'll raise twice as much as we. That's why we have to ask for a 50 cents override tax."

The City Council approved the conditional two-cents tax increase unanimously.

Councilman Bob Jahn, while in favor of the tax increase and benefits, stated that the council's action should have come after the employees were polled as to their desires on the social security matter.

He hoped the council's action

would not prejudice them when they are asked to decide the survey, to be conducted in the future, will cost about \$6000.

The council also approved an overall survey of all city jobs for a job and wage analysis.


