

Horkey, Moore Merger

Merger of Horkey Associates, Angeles engineering firm, and Moore Development corp., Torrance, has been announced by E. J. Horkey, president of the new California corporation, to be known as Harkey-Moore Associates.

Administrative and engineering offices of the newly-merged firm will be located at 24751 S. Crenshaw Blvd., and manufacturing and testing facilities are at 24660 S. Crenshaw Blvd., both in Torrance.

Horkey Associates, organized in 1956, is an engineering, research, design and development firm specializing in aeronautical research and development, and associated investigation.

Moore Development corp., specialized in experimental and prototype fabrication of aircraft components, and environmental testing for major aircraft manufacturers.

Coincident with the merger, the new company now has available in the testing division, facilities for vibration, high and low temperatures, high altitude salt spray, sand and dust, and humidity testing.

In addition to Horkey, other officers of Horkey-Moore Associates are: Joseph H. Moore, vice president-manufacturing and test; John N. Kerr, vice president, engineering; Edwin Stickle, treasurer; James J. Sloan, secretary.

Walter J. Glover, formerly manager of customer relations for Horkey Associates, will serve the new corporation in a similar capacity.

More Beds Slated for Hospital

The Little Company of Mary Building Fund Campaign was successful in attaining the goal of approximately \$2,385,000 for the purpose of constructing a new hospital of 125 beds located in Torrance to serve the Bay area, officials revealed.

Because of the unprecedented growth in population in this area (most recent census, over 90,000 in Torrance alone), it has been decided that the original plans for the hospital should be changed to increase the capacity to a 146-bed hospital.

These additional beds, 21 in number, will call for expenditures exceeding the sum upon which the campaign was based. Many industries, however, will make contributions the latter part of this year, which will help to defray these added costs.
