

Harbor Area Women to Form Osteopathic Hospital Guild

Crawford of 2463 Torrance blvd., will head a delegation of Torrance women next Monday who will join with nearly 100 other women of the harbor area in forming a Harbor Osteopathic Hospital Guild.

The organizational meeting is scheduled for 12:30 p.m. at a luncheon at the San Pedro Hacienda in San Pedro.

Women from Lomita, Harbor City, Redondo, Manhattan and Hermosa Beach, Palos Verdes Estates, Rolling Hills, Wilmington and San Pedro will attend the organizational meeting according to Mrs. Houske.

"Allocation of \$594,882 to the Harbor Osteopathic Hospital by the State department of Health's

hospital committee which distributed Hill-Burton Funds, means that the district has a golden opportunity to secure a 50-bed, badly needed hospital with two-thirds of the cost paid by tax monies from the state and federal government," Mrs. Houske said. She pointed out that the money allotted is from tax monies already collected and on hand and that the district

has only to provide one-third of the building costs or half of the amount given from the Hill-Burton fund, to secure the hospital.

The Disney Foundation and the Gardena Kiwanis club have agreed to share the cost of renting the films every Saturday night for the next 6 months.
