### Rig Made Here Off to Bolivia

After a 15,000-mile journey, by rail, ship, and truck, a big American-made rig will soon be drilling for oil in one of the most remote corners of Bolivia.

Manufactured at Torrance, and other locations, the principal rig components were shipped by rail to Houston for rigging-up and test-operation. The rig was then disassembled and crated for a 12,000-mile sea voyage through the Gulf of Mexico, the Caribbean sea, and the Atlantic ocean, around the hump of Brazil to Buenos Aires, Argentina.

From here it will travel by flatcar to Southern Bolivia, the final 30 kilometers (about 19 miles) from the rail head by truck. Other components, together with pipe, were shipped from Baltimore.

#### Wild Cat Location

The first test hole is planned at Mandeyapeca, Santa Cruz, near the Paraguayan border. This wildcat location is about 100 kilometers (60 miles) southeast from the nearest oil production in the Camiri field. The area is sandy, with sparse vegetation, similar to portions of west Texas, but is only a short distance south of an extensive jungle area.

### Four New Principals Appointed

Children attending four elementary schools in the Harbor and South Bay areas will be greeted by new principals when the Los Angeles City schools begin the 1957-58 year, according to Associate Superintendent Dr. Paul F. Shafer, chief of the city's elementary schools.

The new assignments are purely routine and are being made to fill vacancies caused by retirements, leaves of absence, reassignments or resignations, Dr. Shafer stated.

The four principals affected in these areas are but a portion of the citywide total. Throughout the district, 158 new principal or vice principal appointments will become effective on September 1 in the 520 schools operated by the Los Angeles system.

Although schools will not open until September 16, principals will report to their schools the day after Labor Day—September 3—at which time parents can call any of the Los Angeles schools for registration information.






