Shopping hints can help cooks

Running a home is like running a business, except that the homemaker handles all the jobs. She's chief purchasing agent, manager of the budget, as well as controller of the health of the family. Now and then she needs the counsel of an efficiency expert, and especially if she's fairly new on the job.

The National Association of Retail Grocers has come up with the following shopping tips for cooks:

1. Plan a skeleton menu for the next two or three days.
2. Prepare a complete market order before you shop and make minor changes when you see what is available.
3. Be alert to know what foods are in season.
4. Check labels on cans and other packages for number of servings or pieces and buy the sizes you need.
5. Buy stable items that keep well in large size packages; buy perishable goods only in quantities needed for immediate use.
6. Take time to shop; avoid frantic money-wasting shopping.

A final word of advice from the grocers association is: keep weekend marketing simple by shopping earlier in the week for staples and such other pantry shelf supplies as prepared mixes for cakes and puddings, canned meats and fish, packaged cereals and cookies, Jellies, sauces, syrups, spices and seasonings.

Holiday gifts

Christmas gifts for discriminating persons create dilemmas for shoppers with time limitations. Why not make jellies, preserves and pickles now? Pack them in apothecary jars or other fancy containers and set them aside for a special gift wrap.

Hot dogs

When appetites seem like bottomless pits a hearty stuffing will add staying power to the humble hot dog. Mix 1/2 cup crushed corn chips with 1 cup grated American cheese, add 1 tablespoon finely chopped onion, 1 teaspoon Worcestershire sauce, 4 tablespoons tomato sauce or puree. Split 10 frankfurters lengthwise and fill generously. Bake in preheated oven at 350 degrees for 20 minutes. Serve in split buns with tall glasses of chilled tomato juice.


