**CHURCH OFFICIAL TO SPEAK**

The availability of healthier, happier, more abundant living through spiritual understanding will be the topic of a lecture on Christian Science to be given here Thursday, Oct. 3, by Harry B. MacRae of Dallas, Texas. MacRae, a member of The Christian Science Board of Lectureship, will speak in church edifice, 218th St. and Manual ave., under the auspices of First Church of Christ, Scientist. His subject will be Christian Science. "Its correct view of God and man brings healing." The lecture is free, and local members have invited the public to attend. Mr. MacRae became interested in Christian Science while completing a premedical course at the University of Cincinnati through a physical healing of his father. He withdrew from a business career in 1932 to devote his full time to Christian Science healing. Since 1937 he has been a teacher of Christian Science, and since 1947 he has served as a Christian Science lecturer, traveling widely to speak on Christian Science in this country and abroad.

**'Unreality' Topic for Oct 6**

The Lesson-Sermon in the Christian Science churches on Sunday deals with the reality of the things of God and the inherent unreality of all that is unlike-God. "Hath not God made foolish the wisdom of this world?" keynotes the Golden Text from I Corinthians (1:20). The subject is "Unreality." "Gods promise of blessedness and healing for those who serve him, as revealed to Moses, is given in the Lesson-Sermon from Exodus (23:25), "And ye shall serve the Lord your God, and he shall bless thy bread,

and thy water; and I will take sickness away from the midst of thee." A correlative passage follows from "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy, "Truth is Gods remedy for error of every kind, and Truth destroys only what is untrue. Hence the fact that, today, as yesterday, Christ casts out evils and heals the sick" (p. 142).
