**Welding Teacher Goes Around World in Year**

Selected by Stanford University as one of 22 men from the United States and Hawaii to be sent to the Philippine Islands in an administrative educational capacity, Lester E. Goltart, welding instructor at El Camino College returned to the campus this semester with tales of experiences and souvenirs.

**Training Teachers**  
 On leave of absence for one year, Mr. Goltart was engaged in assisting in the establishment of five teacher training institutions for the Philippine Bureau of Education. The project consisted largely of training Filipino teachers in key institutions and assisting in the development of physical facilities and curriculum.

The purpose of the project was to develop in that country teacher-training institutions in vocational education and industrial arts education similar to those of American state colleges and to change the programs from two to four years.

**Worked in Manila**  
 Mr. Goltart, although glad to be home, said he and his wife and three sons thoroughly enjoyed living and working in Manila. Living among the Filipino people in typical native housing, rather than in an American colony, made it possible to learn more of the habits and customs of these Asiatic people. The instructor's oldest son, Rodger, had the distinction of being the only American boy in his class at a private Filipino school, while Gregory attended a private school for American children and little Stuart, the youngest, was content not to go to school.

Highlight of the project and climaxing the year of hard work in Manila was a two-month tour of Asia and Europe, New York, Washington, D. C., and eastern and middlewestern cities before returning to California.

**Trek Begins**  
 Leaving Manila about May 1, the Goltart family flew to Hong Kong and what was the first stop of a lengthy itinerary. "We reached the Red China border but couldn't get in," said Mr. Goltart, emphasizing, "We didn't want to anyway!"

Next stop was Bangkok, Thailand, where the family visited Buddhist temples and cruised through floating markets on canals much like those found in Venice.

Leaving the land of canals, the Goltarts flew to northern India which the instructor describes as "the land of peacocks and monkeys with black faces and long tails". The Taj Mahal, Red fort, and the Cottage Industries proved interesting.

**Rome**  
 After seeing the sandswept desert of West Pakistan, the new harbor area and several new government buildings in Karachi, the Goltart family winged its way to Rome. A horse and buggy provided ideal transportation to St. Peter's, part of the Vatican, and the old Colosseum and ancient ruins.

Geneva, Switzerland, beckoned next and while in this little country the family rented a car and journeyed to South France.

**Germany**  
 Next was Frankfurt, Germany, and according to Mr. Goltart, at this point the children were ready to find a playground. Stated the genial shop mentor, "We realized there is no distinction between race and creed among children. After fifteen minutes they were playing with the German children and having a wonderful time."

From the industrialized Germany the trip led to Brussels, Belgium where the Royal Palace, museum and lace-making industry were of interest.

**France**  
 The Arch de Triomphe, Eiffel Tower, and underground railway highlighted the Paris portion of the trip, which included a visit with Dr. and Mrs. Harold Loper. Dr. Loper is director of education for UNESCO.

Mr. and Mrs. G.A.M. Snyders hosted the Goltarts in Holland and took them on a tour of the famous dikes. Mr. Snyders was resident instructor at El Camino a few years ago.

**England**  
 In England the Tower of London, London Bridge and Big Ben were viewed, while in Denmark the teacher and family sampled a few of the "two hundred kinds of open faced sandwiches to be found in Copenhagen."

The European and Asian junket over, the Goltarts plane left Copenhagen with New York as its destination. After enjoying the sights of "Gotham," Washington, D. C., Cleveland and Denver, where Mr. Goltart visited his mother and relatives, the family arrived in Los Angeles recently, loaded down with souvenirs and colored slides to provide an adequate memory of 14 months in a real-life adventure.
