



Spiritual Understanding Destroys Evil Says Sermon

The arresting words of Habakkuk, "Art thou not from everlasting, O Lord my God, mine Holy One? we shall not die," open the Lesson-Sermon "Are Sin, Disease, and Death Real?" in all Churches of Christ, Scientist, on Sunday. Habakkuk's words continue, "Thou art of purer eyes than to behold evil, and canst not look on iniquity." A reference from Psalms continues this thought, "That thy way may be known upon earth, thy saving health among all nations." (Hab. 1:12, 13; PS. 67:2).

A companion reference from "Science and Health with Key to the Scriptures" by Mary Baker Eddy declares, "If God, the All-in-all, be the creator of the spiritual universe, including man, then everything entitled to a classification as truth, or Science, must be comprised in a knowledge or understanding of God, for there can be nothing beyond illimitable divinity" (p. 127).

The Golden Text of the sermon is taken from Solomon's words in Proverbs (12:28), "In the way of righteousness is life; and in the pathway thereof there is no death."


