

### Harbor College Schedules Tests

Everyone who intends to enroll as a new day student at Harbor Junior College for the Spring 1958 session is urged to take the pre-registration guidance tests. William H. McMasters, Dean of Admissions and Guidance said today.

During October the tests, which take three hours to complete, will be given at the College Monday, October 14, at 9 a.m. and Tuesday, October 22, at 9 a.m. Anyone who wishes to do so may take these entrance guidance tests on either of the above dates.

"Harbor's guidance testing program is designed to assist the individual in choosing the type of educational program from which he will receive greatest benefit. All those who intend to enroll for either day or extended-day classes will benefit by taking the tests and may secure further information by calling the College," McMasters said.

### Ask Extension Of Freeway

A campaign to extend construction of the Harbor Freeway to Pacific Coast Highway was opened last week by the Carson Civic Betterment Association, J. R. Gateley, president, announced.

The association asked County Supervisor Burton W. Chace to do what he could to extend the freeway from 190 st. where it is now to terminate. The group made its request after hearing a report from two California Highway Patrol officers that the accident hazard would increase if the freeway ended at 190 st.

The CHP officers also reported that the ratio of fatalities in accidents occurring on Figueroa st. between 208 st. and Lomita blvd. was abnormally high. They said the ratio was one fatality in nine accidents, as against an average ratio of one in 15 in other areas.

### Civilians to Attend U. S. Day Fete

A delegation of members of Torrance's Civitan Club will attend the United States Day celebration at Sentinel Field in Inglewood, October 23, according to M. W. Heimerdinger, president.

The public observance of United States Day is being initiated in the Southwest by Civitan Club of Inglewood, as an expression of patriotic appreciation for the freedom and happiness enjoyed by American citizens under the Constitution of the United States.

Admission is free to the open-air night program of band music, singing, and patriotic exercises. Los Angeles County Counsel, Harold W. Kennedy, will deliver the main address.

Residents in outlying cities of the peninsula and Centinela valley are forming car caravans which will parade to Sentinel Field, located at Inglewood avenue and Kelso street. Citizens

elsewhere in the County are planning to attend.

Civitan Club issues a cordial invitation to all citizens of Torrance to participate in the patriotic event. Five thousand free seats are available. Grounds and plays will open at 7 p.m., admission free. Four M 41 Bulldog Tanks and a replica of the aircraft carrier Forrestal will be on display, provided through courtesy of the California National Guard, Inglewood Zone, and Los Alamitos Naval Air Station.


