Harvest O' Fun at Flavian School will begin today October 31, with a costume parade in the kindergarten playground at 6 p.m.


This PTA sponsored carnival will have games, food, movies and booths of homemade articles.

Father McGuinness Being Transferred to Lynwood

The Rev. Patrick J. McGuinness, pastor of the Catholic Church of the Nativity, has received word from his Ecclesiastical Superiors that he has been appointed as the new pastor of St. Emydius Catholic church in Lynwood.
The appointment was made last Tuesday, October 21, by the Archbishop of Los Angeles, J. Francis Cardinal McIntyre, and was occasioned by the death of the Lynwood pastor, Rev. Charles J. O'Carroll, who died two weeks ago.
Father McGuinness has been pastor of the local church for thirteen years during which time he has seen the membership grow from 1,200 to 7,000. In that period, the church and rectory have been enlarged and a convent and eight classroom school have been built. The auxiliary church of St. Joseph in Pueblo has also been remodeled and new property purchased. At the present time, construction is actually under way for another eight classroom addition in the Nativity Parochial school site.

The new pastor of Nativity Catholic church will be the Rev. Joseph McArdle, who is a native son of California, and, at present, pastor of the Church of the Assumption in East Los Angeles. He was also chaplain in the United States Navy during the last World War and is a fluent Spanish speaker.
These changes take effect on Tuesday, November 5.
