Royce Jones enlisted as an Airman Recruit and will attend Airman School in Norman, Okla. after training and boot leave. His parents, Mr. and Mrs. Aron Jones live at 1022 West 210th street.

Lee made an outstanding mark on his examinations and was enlisted as an Electronic Field Seaman Recruit and is guaranteed schooling and training in the electronic field.

Morton is assigned to an LST with his home port in San Diego. Fields arranged for him to take his high school level tests at Long Beach during his recruit leave and he will receive the results of these tests in the near future.

Buggeln will report to the U. S. Naval School of Machinery's Mates at Great Lakes, Ill., and will receive instruction in main propulsion machinery and auxiliaries, operation, maintenance and repair, handtools, gauges and instruments as used in operating auxiliary machinery such as refrigeration equipment, evaporators, pumps, compressors, heat exchangers, and emergency electrical generators.

Knight will report to Naval Air Station, Corpus Christi, Texas for four months of instruction and then will go to Airman School at Norman, Okla. which will equip him for assignment to Aviation Electronics Technician School to learn how to test, maintain and repair all airborne electronics communications, navigation, search, identification, counter-measures, detection, and relay equipment and associated equipment.
