A full slate of events is scheduled for Junior Achievement Week to be celebrated January 26 through February 1, according to an announcement today by James S. Cantlen, chairman of the J. A. In Los Angeles, where 850 students from 30 high schools run 65 junior firms at three business centers in Burbank, Hawthorne, and West Los Angeles, the week-long observance also honors the more than 200 advisers, representing 44 consulting firms, who provide guidance and leadership to the young businessmen and women.

The local program is now in its fourth year of operation. One of the highlights of the week will be the kick-off luncheon for "Operation Contact-1958," the J. A. fund campaign, at the Statler hotel on Tuesday, January 28. Under campaign chairman, Horace W. Brower, Occidental Life Insurance company, nearly 100 volunteers will launch the drive for \$103,500 to support the 1958 "learn-by-doing" program.

Other activity, according to Cantlen, will include speaking engagements at leading service clubs which will feature junior achievers on their programs. Department stores and other concerns will also tell the J. A. story through window displays in strategic locations throughout the Southland.

National and local radio and television stations will feature junior achievement regularly during the week through guest appearances of achievers and spot announcers. In addition, many business firms will carry J. A. stories in their company publications saluting Los Angeles' junior achievement activities.

On February 1, the achievers will conduct a trade fair at the Burbank center while junior achievers at the Hawthorne and West Los Angeles business centers will host scores of visitor at open house nightly in each center during the week.

**Supervisors Back Water Conversion**

On motion of Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, the Board of Supervisors today voted to support Senate Joint Resolution 135, by Senator Clinton P. Anderson, New Mexico, calling for the construction of a \$10,000,000 plant for the conversion of fresh water from the sea water.

County Counsel Harold W. Kennedy was instructed by Supervisor Hahn's motion to contact California Congressman and congressional committees in support of the Senate Resolution.

Speaking in favor of his motion, Supervisor Hahn declared that Los Angeles County would be the ideal location for a salt water conversion plant.

Senator Anderson's resolution does not specify the type of energy to be used in the salt conversion unit. Supervisor Hahn said that he believed the Federal Government should investigate the possibility of using atomic energy to power the plant.
