Air Pollution Violations Indicate Marked Drop this Year, Griswold Says

Smog violations during the past month showed a decided drop below violations reported a year ago as the Air Pollution Control District continued its strict enforcement of smog laws.

Control Officer Smith Griswold reported today that despite 9,101 inspections of industry, refinery, and petro-chemical plants during March-only 217 notices of smog violation were written by APCD inspectors.

During the same period last year 276 notices were written. As of March 31, he reported, 212 court cases had been completed with 194 persons pleading guilty, 10 others were found guilty, two received acquittal and six cases were dismissed. Last year during the same period 236 cases were handled in County courts. As the current month began, 577 cases were still awaiting court action.

Griswold said fines, again for the third straight month, showed a decrease over the same period a year ago with only \$5,844 levied by the courts as against \$8,769 last year for the same month.

Since January 1 courts have assessed fines amounting to \$17,189 against smog violators as compared to total fines of \$28,204 during the same three month period in 1957.

The Air Pollution Hearing Board conducted hearings in 31 cases as compared to 55 last year in March but had 49 cases still pending before it at the end of the month.

Hearings held before the board since January 1 total 106, an increase of two over the corresponding period in 1957.


