Anniversary Observed at Temple Menorah

Dr. Biran's speech will be delivered at the Sabbath services, which are open to the public. Dr. Biran is speaking as part of Temple Menorah's celebration of the Tenth Anniversary of the State of Israel.

The Temple Menorah choir is under the direction of the organist, Fay Newman. Dr. Matthew J. A reception (Oneg Shabbat) in honor of Dr. Biran will follow the services.
