

### Steel Plant Here To Shut Down for Vacation Period

Torrance Works of US Steel's Columbia-Geneva Steel Division will be shut down for a scheduled vacation period, June 28 to July 14. It was announced today. With the exception of mini-

mill crews in the maintenance, shipping and industrial relations departments, all wage, salaried and management employees will take their annual vacations at this time. The mill has a total

employment of about 700. The 36-22 inch rolling mill is scheduled to close down at midnight, June 26, and the 12-inch rolling mill is slated to close down at midnight, June 27. Both

rolling mill departments will resume operations at 8 a. m. July 14. The open hearth department, which employs about 90 persons, will be down from midnight, June 28, to midnight, July 20, on the vacation schedule.
