

### Ryan Will Not Transfer Jetliner Work to Torrance

A proposed transfer of production work on jetliner parts to the Torrance plant, was canceled by the Ryan Aeronautical Co. Instead, the firm will erect a new building in San Diego for the DC-8 pod and pylon assembly.

The company said that the move to the Torrance division was dropped after facilities were made available and this will lead to the retention of 1500 employees in the San Diego area.

The Torrance plant at present is geared to quantity production of remote-controlled jet target drones, the Firebee, which is being supplied to the Air Force, the Navy and the Canadian Air Force.
