

### 1000 Tickets Sold for Scout-O-Rama in Harbor Area

Scout-O-Rama ticket sales in the Harbor District jumped to 1000 for the Boy Scouts "big show" 1 to 10 p.m., May 24 in the Coliseum. The figure was announced at the first ticket sales report meeting.

9000 more tickets are expected to be sold in the district, according to D. Boone Kirks ticket sales chairman.

An overall attendance of 111,000 is anticipated to the Scout-O-Rama in which 20,000 Cubs, Boy Scouts and Explorers are participating.

Booths featuring Scouts and their cooperating partners in industry will be open between 1 and 8:30 p.m., at which time the giant stage show will begin.

Hollywood, sports and Scout talent will take part in the show to be performed on a huge structure especially constructed for the occasion. Mrs. Joan Woodbury Wilcoxon, actress-director-producer and wife of Henry Wilcoxon, associate producer of the forthcoming Paramount picture, "The Buccaneer" is producing the show.

Tickets are on sale for one dollar from Cubs, Boy Scouts and Explorers in the 13 districts of the Los Angeles Area Council of Boy Scouts.
