

**Song of Norway Opens Today at El Camino College Campus Theater**

"Cheers, bravos, and handclapping will be a long time dying out when "Song of Norway" opens in the El Camino Campus Theater today," according to impartial observers who have sneaked preview glimpses of the production during rehearsals. Music lovers in particular should enjoy this operetta which has become a classic in the field along with "Blossom Time," "Roselinda," "Rose Marie," "Vagabond King" and "Student Prince."

Constructed from the life and tunes of Edvard Grieg, "Song of Norway" is a romantic period piece of the first water. Grieg's music, effectively used as it is in this work, is gay and colorful, and for the most part, not so widely known as to be immediately recognizable to the general public. There are, exceptions, notably "Ich Liesbe Dich," selections from "Peer Gynt," and the Piano Concerto played in its entirety. "Norway" utilizes this music in traditional operetta fashion, with reprises, choruses, and swelling operatic crescendos. It also contains ballet, comedy, and folk dances. In "Blossom Time," the songs

of Franz Schubert reached the stage as did those of Frederic Chopin in "Polonaise." They gave these immortal masters an even wider audience than they had enjoyed before; "Song of Norway" does the same favor for Edvard Grieg. The musical adaptations were made by Robert Wright and George Forrest,

while Milton Lasarus, working from a play by Homer Curran, built the story depicting Grieg's life.

Included in the cast are Fred Lincoln, of Torrance, as Nordrask, Lee Smith, of Manhattan Beach, as Nina, Bruce Steiner, of Hawthorne, as Grieg, K. Lype O'Dell of Hermosa, as Father Grieg Neal J. Jardine of Hawthorne, as Father Nordrask, June Picclair of Lawndale, as Mother Grieg, Michael Binette of Redondo, as the Count, Marjorie Gibson of Hawthorne, as

the Countess, Jayne Turner of Torrance, as Frau Professor Norden, Barbara Baldwin of Garden Grove, as Miss Anders, Gary Shaffer of Gardena, as Ibsen, Charles Turner of Hermosa, as Pisoni, and Taha Rey of El Segundo, as Adelina.

Donald Ferguson is designing the show, Calvin Greer conducting the orchestra, and Neil Hill directing the ensemble. Choreography is by Don Weissmuller, costumes are by James and Winnie Chandler Logan, technical direction by Leslie Thomas.

**College to Hold Instructional Art Exhibit May 16, 18**


