Swimming Signups Accepted

Reservations for swimming lessons in the El Camino College pools for the final summer instruction period, August 18 through 29, will be available from 8 a.m. until 4:30 p.m. today in the college business office. Classes for 10, 11 and 12-year olds will be conducted from 8 a.m. until 9 a.m. daily through-out the period, while instruction for 7, 8, and 9-year-olds will start at 9 a.m., 11 a.m. and at 2, 3, and 4 p.m. daily. Instruction tickets for adults

are also available for the coming two-week period. Hours for swimming lessons for those 18 years of age or over are conducted from 7 to 8 and from 8 to 9 nightly. Cost of the swimming lessons is \$1 per two-week period. Minimum height for the swimming program is 52 inches. Swimmers must furnish their own suits and towels; girls must wear bathing caps. Adults may purchase instruction tickets for children only if the children are present, the college emphasized.

Recreational swimming hours through August 29 are conducted each Saturday from 8 until 10 a.m., 10 a.m. until 12 noon, and from 1 until 3 p.m. Minimum age is 7. Adults 18 and over may swim from 9 until 10 p.m. Monday through Friday. The 6 to 7 hour each evening is reserved as a Family Hour, when adults, 18 years and older and children under 18, accompanied by parents, may swim. Charge for recreational swimming is 25 cents for adults and 10 cents for children under 18 years.

Pact on Bridge Approved

In preparation for the permanent improvement and reconstruction of Dominguez channel between Denker avenue and Gramercy place, for which bids will be opened on August 22, the board of supervisors this week approved an agreement between the Flood Control District and Torrance for bridge and street improvements in connection with the project, according to Supervisor Kenneth Hahn. The agreement, which had earlier been signed by Mayor Albert Isen, calls for cooperative widening of new bridges to be built across the channel at Western avenue and at Gramercy place. It will also include improving the approaches to the bridges. Supervisor Kenneth Hahn, who has urged that improvement of the channel be expedited to provide maximum flood control

to Gardena, Torrance and the Gardena and Centinela Valleys, pointed out that bridge improvements are vital. "The narrow culverts now under these streets are inadequate to carry the flow of storm water. They catch debris which dams the channel and causes the water to back up and overflow the banks," he pointed out. The two bridges will be reconstructed to master plans standards. The channel reach under the bridges will be widened to 75 feet and will have a depth of approximately 18 feet.




