Maestri Promotion Announced

Promotion of Lt. John Maestri to captain as of Oct. 1, was announced today by Police Chief Percy G. Bennett.

Maestri will receive the promotion a week before his 41st birthday on Oct. 7.

A Navy veteran of World War II, he joined the Torrance Police Department on Nov. 16, 1946, and received his training from Bennett, who was then a sergeant. Maestri became a sergeant in April, 1952, and lieutenant on July 1, 1957.

He was number one on the eligibility list following a recent civil service examination.

Bennett said that Maestri will be assigned to administrative functions until the return of M. H. Porter, assistant chief, now attending the FBI academy.

No other promotions will be made immediately, the chief said.

Others who passed the captain's examination are Lis. A. S. Thompson, T. A. Morris, and D. C. Cook.

The only other captain in the department, Ernest Ashton, has been on sick leave for several months.

Maestri's appointment was the first time a captain has been appointed in 18 years.
