STUFFED MUSHROOMS

Hawthorne Juniors
1 tsp. finely chopped onion
1 2 1/2-ounce can deviled ham
1/4 tsp. seasoned salt
1 6-ounce can mushroom crowns, drained—melted butter
1 tsp. butter
1/4 cup soft bread crumbs
1/4 tsp. Worcestershire sauce
Cook onion in 1 tsp. butter over low heat until tender but not brown. Combine with deviled ham, crumbs, seasoned salt and Worcestershire sauce. Stuff mushrooms with mixture; brush with melted butter. Broil stuffed side up 5-8 minutes. Serve hot.

AVOCADO BUTTER SPREAD

El Segundo Juniors
1 ripe avocado
1/2 tsp. salt
4 tsp. lemon juice
1 tsp. chili sauce
dash of cayenne pepper
Cut avocado in half lengthwise. Remove seed; scoop out pulp, keeping shells intact. Mash pulp and blend with other ingredients. Refill shells. Serve at once. Use as a spread on crackers, toast, bread sticks, potato chips, or celery stalks.

1 large package cream cheese
4 slices bacon, chop, cook and drain
Worcestershire sauce (dash)
1/2 tsp. salt
