### Citizens Group Backs Bonds in Tuesday's Election

Support for the \$15,000,000 school bond issue, to be decided Tuesday, was given this week by the Torrance Citizens for Better Schools.

The group, renamed from the Science-Education Council, was one of the district's bitterest critics during the board of education election earlier this year. Spokesmen for the organization said that current forecasts of the future needs of the district, may actually be on the conservative side, following study of the city's population growth.

They pointed out that a "yes" vote does not commit the district to expend money on specific projects, and that the Board of Education retains control over use of the bond money.

The group conceded that the only alternative to passing the bond issue is to accept double sessions.
