**Warhoop Wins Tenth Award for Excellence**

All-American honors in the field of junior college newspaper production were awarded the Warhoop of El Camino College this week for the tenth consecutive semester, Merl F. Sloan, director of student personnel, announced today.

Only four junior college papers in the nation were included in the All-American classification with the Warhoop, weekly news publication of the college. The evaluation is made each semester by the Associated Collegiate Press, which maintains headquarters on the campus of the University of Minnesota in Minneapolis. Judges are professionals in the field of journalism, most of them graduates of journalism schools.

In scoring the Warhoop, judges noted superiority of the paper in the field of photography and sports coverage. The paper was also cited for excellence in typography, printing, headlines, head schedule, make-up, editorials, style and general reporting. Weakness outlined pertained specifically to problems in copy and proof reading.

Commissioner of publications last year was K. Lye O'Dell, under whom two All-American awards were achieved. Editor-in-chief for the two semesters were Birchell Barrett and Miss Joyce Huffman.

Serving in the staff positions with Miss Huffman were Gary Palmer of Torrance, city editor; Mrs. Karen Leslie, feature editor; Jack Simpson, sports editor; Palmer assumed the sports editor's position at mid-semester, while Mrs. Leslie became city editor and O'Dell edited the feature section.

Reporters were Al Montoya of Torrance, Dick White, Emma Mills, Torrance and Don Ferguson.

Bill Robison and Jesse Amado Jr. of Torrance and Jim Murphy were staff photographers,

while Gary Fowler, Torrance, and Harvey Rosen, shared advertising management of the paper.






