

Henry W. Behrens Named New Arlington School Principal

Vice Principal Henry W. Behrens is the new principal of Arlington School this week. He succeeds Malcolm Richland, principal for the past two years who resigned to take a position with the Systems Development Co. Richland formerly was principal at Fern-Greenwood School.

Behrens has served as Arlington vice principal this fall, previously serving in the same capacity at Seaside and Perry Schools. He also has been a teaching principal at Shandon, Calif., and a vice principal in an Army Dependent School in France.

Widely travelled, he spent World War II in a Japanese prison camp. He was captured on Dec. 7, 1941, when he was aboard a Merchant Marine vessel evacuating Marines from

China. He was not released until 1945. He holds a bachelor's degree from the University of California at Santa Barbara and a master's degree from the University of Southern California.

Married and the father of two daughters, Behrens lives at 420 Via Linda Vista, Hollywood Riviera.
