**Del Amo Work Starts Dec. 1**

Improvement of another block on the north side of Plaza Del Amo east of Western Ave., is provided for in a contract awarded this week, it was announced today by City Council President John S. Gibson. Progressive Paving Co. was the lowest of five bidders on the project which includes a full width improvement with curbs, gutters and sidewalks between Harvard Blvd. and Denker St. Cost of the project was set at \$14,211 which was four per cent

lower than estimates. Of this amount the city will contribute \$1,787 to pay for the additional width of the roadway in excess of the normal assessment to property owners. Work is expected to begin before Dec. 1, according to the Board of Public Works.
