Claim Southern California to Double in Growth

Southern California's tremendous population boom will continue at a rapid pace during the next two decades and reach an estimated 17,349,000 by 1980 or nearly double the present population, it was predicted today.

A new and detailed set of population forecasts, completed after six months effort by many of the Southland's top research analysts, was unveiled by the research committee of the Los Angeles Chamber of Commerce.

The report disclosed that Orange County is expected to experience the area's greatest percentage growth cycle in the next 22 years with an expected gain of 241 percent from 560,000 to 1,910,000.

Los Angeles County will continue to receive the large portion of the Southern California growth, increasing by over 4,000,000 from the present 5,730,000 to an estimated 9,900,000 in 1980, the report stated.




