The first million-and-a-quarter vehicle registration renewal notices for 1959 are in the mail this week addressed to owners of commercial vehicles and trailers of all types. The Department of Motor Vehicles announced today.

Registrations of these types of vehicles may be renewed for next year between now and

February 4, 1959, without drawing penalties under State law. Owners who present their fees with their statement cards in person at DMV offices will receive a 1959 registration card and a silver-white renewal sticker for the rear plate, to be placed over the expiring 1958 green sticker. Passenger car statements will not be released to the mails by DMV until Dec. 26, for renewal between Jan. 2 and Feb. 4.


