**Youth Falls Down Steep Ravine**  
 Donald Eugene Hickman, 15-year-old South High School student, suffered a head injury, when he toppled 35 feet down a ravine on the end of Paseo de las Tortugas Saturday afternoon.  
 The youth, of 5502 Via del Valle, was pulled out of the 75-foot ravine with a basket stretcher by Torrance firemen.  
 Two other youths who were with him, Steve Kuhn, 11, of 5114 Via El Sereno, and Bob Higdon, 15, of 5205 Via El Sereno, said that Hickman had climbed half way down the ravine and was holding on to a vine when he fell, striking his head on the way down.  
 Firemen stretched a rope across the ravine and lowered a stretcher to pull Hickman out. He was taken to Pacific View Hospital, Hermosa Beach.

**Victor School Site Pondered If Merger OK'd**

A 15-acre elementary school site at the southeast corner of Spencer and Victor Sts. is being eyed by the Torrance Unified School District if the Board of Supervisors approve the annexation of the Victor Tract to the district.  
 Assistant Superintendent S. E. Waldrip told the School Board Tuesday night that if the annexation is approved at a hearing today the district will start proceedings to obtain the school site.  
 "We must act quickly to get the site as cheaply as possible," he said. "A study of the area indicates that there may be too many children for one school and not enough to justify two."
