Baptists to Hold Revival Services

The First Baptist Church of Lomita will begin a series of Revival Services March 15 through March 23 in cooperation with a Nation-wide Simultaneous Crusade with nineteen million Baptists in 75,000 churches participating in a cooperative witness.

Rev. Bill Austin, pastor at Palo Alto, and Rev. James Bell will be featured as special speakers at the First Baptist Church. Austin is the author of "Talks to Timothy," and is a member of the writing staff of the Sunday School Board in Nashville. Accompanying him will be "Skipper," his ventriloquist friend popular with children and young people. Austin was one of the main speakers this year at the California Baptist Convention and is much in demand for assemblies and revivals.

James Bell, pastor of the Second Baptist Church of Norwalk, is a former combat pilot who answered the call to the ministry while serving in the 14th Air Force in China. While in service he was awarded the distinguished flying cross with oak leaf cluster, the air medal and combat citations.

The music is under the direction of Dick Wallner, local music director. A full choir will present special numbers each evening.

Captain Fuchida will tell why he was chosen by the High Command of the Imperial Japanese Navy to lead the air attack, why as a loyal soldier and officer, he followed the orders of the high command as he was trained to do.

He will tell how God, through His Word (the Bible) converted his life from war to peace; and how he is now spending the remainder of his life preaching the Gospel message of Peace.
