**Pupil Expense Here Below State Average, Hull Says**

The Torrance Unified School District's expenses per pupil still run considerably below the state-wide average, according to a report to the Board of Education Tuesday night. Torrance currently spends \$323.21 per pupil compared with an average of \$381.03 for other unified districts in California, according to figures compiled by the State Department of Education. At the same time, Torrance has an assessed valuation average of \$8,575 per elementary pupil, about \$3000 less than the state-wide average. Its high school assessed valuation average is \$40,314, about \$3000 more than the state-wide average. About three-fourths of the local pupils are in elementary schools. In 12 budget categories, Torrance was above the state average in only two categories—instructional supplies and transportation of pupils. Largest chunk of the budget money goes for teachers' salaries. Here, the Torrance average is \$208, compared with the state's \$251. This is due in large part to the fact that the average Torrance teacher is newer and younger than in many of the state's older districts. Maintenance costs are only about half of the state-wide average because most of Torrance's schools are new. Average costs will rise as teachers advance on the salary schedule and as schools get older, Superintendent J. H. Hull said. Increasing emphasis on math, science, vocational training, audio-visual aids, programs for brighter students, and other courses also will mean added expenses, he said. Average costs per pupil in Torrance (with state-wide averages in parentheses) are: Teachers' salaries, \$208 (\$251); operation of plants, \$36.16 (\$37.63); instructional supplies, \$18.15 (\$15.45); fixed charges, \$12.09 (\$18.68); administration, \$12.08 (\$12.77); non-teaching salaries, \$11.27 (\$13.77); auxiliary services, \$9.30 (\$9.22); plant maintenance, \$8.03 (\$15.99); transportation of pupils, \$7.83 (\$5.67). **High Schoolers At Journalism Event at ECC**
