Gangs from Torrance and Harbor Cities create many of the problems created by them in Lomita, Donald Barnes and Lou Farlow, Lomita sheriff's juvenile officers, said. They told the association that "foreign" intruders account for most of the party-crashing and other disturbances.

The officers said that they try to prevent as many as possible of the cruising gangs from ever entering the residential community. They advised parents to check on parties given by teenagers to learn how many of them are invited.

Mrs. Desdie Myers, president of the association, announced that she believes that sufficient signatures have been obtained for the proposed annexation of the area to the County Water District No. 13.

The petition drive was started because of dissatisfaction with low water pressure in Narbonne Ranch Water Co. No. 2 which serves the northern portion of Lomita.
