OUTDOORS with MEL

I thought I would discuss the basic type of salt water fishing tackle. This will include boat, surf and pier.
The choice is up to the fisherman regarding casting or spinning tackle. I prefer the spinning because it enables the fisherman to cast a light lure or bait a long distance without any backlash or tangle. The cost is about double that of standard tackle. The standard tackle is a little more universal as it can be used for other types of fishing such as trolling and bottom fishing.
THE ROD
The average rod is 8 to 9 1/2 feet long. It is made of fibreglass, which is both strong and light in weight. Tests have shown that a spinning rod can be used with a standard reel and gives the fisherman a long-cast. The things to look for

are good wrapping on guides, a tight fit in the handle, and good hardware to resist salt water corrosion.
THE REEL
It should be of salt water-resistant material. The newly developed plastics hold up very well. The standard roll should hold about 200 to 250 yards of line. It should have a good drag system to tire the fish without breaking the line.
Things to look for: the reel should be of a standard make. This assures that parts are available when wear and salt water break them down. The quick lubrication and quick take-apart features are important, especially in surf fishing.

OTHER TACKLE
A salt water-resistant tackle box, nylon line, hooks, swivels, leaders, sinkers, lure or jigs, and pliers. These can be supplied by any good sporting goods store and they are glad to advise you on the type of tackle and how and where to use it.
