Heath to Head South Bay Area Cerebral Palsy Fund Drive

Marvin Heath, 1528 Cravens Ave., has been appointed South Bay area chairman for United Cerebral Palsy's annual May appeal, according to D. Loring Marlett, countywide chairman of the campaign, the "53 Minute March."

In announcing Heath's appointment today, Marlett also pointed out that he will be aided in his work by Mrs. Dalton M. Davis, 5183 Willow Wood Rd., Rolling Hills; Mrs. Lynn Y. Newman, 2322 West 184th St., and Miss Mary L. Fadel, 304 Paseo de la Playa. "When I first learned that every 53 minutes a child is born with cerebral palsy, the most cruel and costly multiplecrippler man knows, and that 17,000 persons in the county are afflicted with this condition, I realized how important it is for all of us to help these people learn to adjust to their handicaps and lead happier, more useful lives," Heath said.

Heath will draw on his community service experience gained through Lions Club and Chamber of Commerce membership in organizing the area campaign. His three attractive assistants, with the aid of neighborhood leaders, will direct the "53 Minute March" in their respective communities.
