

Resignation Causes Shift of Two Elementary School Principals Here

Two elementary schools will have new principals Monday as the result of shifts following the resignation of Herb Ferris, principal at Meadow Park School for the past five years.

D. Boone Kirks, Torrance Elementary School principal, will take Ferris' place at Meadow Park School. Stanley G. Roberts has been named acting principal at Torrance Elementary School and will be up for approval of the Board of Education next week. Roberts is now Casimir School vice principal.

Ferris, a resident at 3219 Danaha St., resigned this week to take a job with private industry.

The new Meadow Park principal, Kirks, had been Torrance Elementary principal for the past six years, previously heading the Walteria School program from 1947 to 1953. He came to Torrance from Escondido, where he was a principal and teacher.

A native of Long Beach, the 48-year-old Kirks graduated from the University of Redlands and holds a master's degree from UCLA. He has been active in Boy Scout work here and is a member of the Executives Dinner Club.

He and his wife, Audrey, live at 22916 Cabrillo Ave., with their four children—Sharon, Kathy, Danny, and Larry.

The 47-year-old Roberts, who will take over at Torrance Elementary, has been with the Torrance schools for four years, serving at Casimir, Seaside, Perry, and Edison Schools.

He served three years as executive secretary of the Torrance YMCA. He also served as YMCA secretary in Grand Island, Nebr., and Topeka, Kans., before coming here. A native of Minnesota, he graduated from Macalester College. He expects to receive a master's degree from Long Beach State College in June.

A resident at 1225 Hickoy Ave., he and his wife, Ruth, have three children—Alvyn, Gerald, and Kathryn. He served as a lieutenant commander in the Navy during the war.
