Local Scouts Training Week

The rigors of Air Force survival training were experienced first hand by 11 local Explorer Scouts recently.

The scouts from Explorer Post 728X accompanied by leader, Herman Hoodman, received Department of the Air Force training certificates for satisfactorily completing the Air Explorer Scout Encampment given by the 3635th Flying Training Group (Advanced), Stead AFB, Nevada, over a full week of the Easter holidays.

Arriving Sunday by bus at the State Bldg. in Reno, the local group was assigned an Air Force instructor, toured the display buildings, checked equipment, set up camp and received the survival lecture.

Early morning found them in a convoy and a 60-mile snowy route to the training area, where they constructed camp and were issued military C-rations. The rest of the day was spent in further camp construction utilizing Air Force tepees, in fire building, camp sanitation, campfire discussion and forest procedures.

Wednesday featured hunting, stalking, fishing, skinning, and the actual preparation of rabbits in rock ovens. Also, information on plant food, as well as a helicopter and snow "weasel" demonstration. A 12-mile mountaineering jaunt followed and training was given in navigation and map reading, trail techniques and trail discipline.

Instructions in signaling and signal fires, mountaineering, traps and snares, cooking methods comprised Thursday's instructions, with Friday devoted to preparing for the return jaunt as the snow was starting to melt, graduation and departure to Reno for the bus trip back to Los Angeles and Torrance.
