Participating in the competition were 37 students of the college cosmetology department, 14 classified as seniors and 23 as juniors. Miss Necia Cochran of Hawthorne was named winner of the junior division with a style called "Inspiration."

Mrs. Ostling and Miss Cochran were recipients of trophies, while other winners in each

division won certificates in recognition of their achievements.

Judging the contest were representatives of the hairstyling profession, instructors of cosmetology and previous winners of trophies or other awards in the field of hairstyling.

Junior classes competed primarily for accuracy in hairstyling, while seniors were judged on the basis of originality and technique.

The contest climaxed weeks of preparation on the part of students. Each participant was required to furnish her own model.

Latest styles in hair design, new hair shades and general technique were featured.
