

Turkish Diplomat Attends Model UN Session at South High School

World problems got earnest consideration from South High School sophomores, who have been participating in model United Nations sessions recently as part of their social studies programs.

Their model sessions had a note of authenticity added Thursday as Semih Akbil, first secretary of the Turkish Embassy in Washington and alternate delegate to the United Nations, addressed the students.

The Turkish official praised the students for their interest in current events and gave them some background on world affairs from his nation's point of view. After his talk, the model United Nations' secretary-general, Alan Sims, presented Akbil with a citation from the students.

The South High sessions, held in the school gymnasium, are modeled as closely as possible on the actual meetings in New York. Desks are arranged in a semi-circle around the president's table, with flags of all nations hung around the gym.

Robbie Hole was named president of the Security Council, while Clayton Moore won election as Assembly president. Paul Anthony, Dan Clark, Ted Ross, and Neal Salsberry were chosen Assembly vice presidents.

After plans were made for the model sessions, various students were assigned countries to represent. They wrote to the missions and embassies of these countries and many received extensive literature on the nations. Representatives of each country also arranged for a flag of the country to be made by the home economics department.

Debate in the model United Nations centered about the peaceful uses of outer space and the question of independence for the Cameroons.
