Youth Car Run Entries Due Today

Thirty-two cars will arrive in Torrance today in preparation for the sixth annual Youth Safety Run which starts here Sunday at 5 a.m.

The grueling 857-mile trip to Yosemite will be judged on miles per gallon performance except for the sweepstakes which will be judged on ton miles, according to the sponsors, the Police Advisory Council for car clubs.

The cars, all furnished by dealers, will return here sometime Tuesday evening.

The cars will be stored in the impound area at the National Guard Armory beginning tonight following last minute tune-ups.

Among the entries from Torrance are two cars, a Rambler, sponsored by Dwight Eubank Rambler, and a Ford sponsored by Vel's Ford.

The Rambler team is made up of Chuck Comstock, 18, driver, Bob Newell, 18, co-driver, and Dick Marion, 24, observer.

The Ford team is composed of Brent Shirley, 18, driver, Lloyd Steele, 17, co-driver, and an observer yet to be named.

The petitions assert that presently many patrons are discouraged from using the libraries because they find them closed so often.

Summer Classes to Start

Summer school classes will begin Monday in all Torrance schools, giving nearly a third of the regular school children only a week's vacation. Classes will let out on July 31.

More than 8800 youngsters have signed up for the summer sessions which will be a continuation of the regular year's program. Classes are designed to help the bright, slow, and students in between. Some 1900 high school and 6900 elementary students have signed up.

Classes are scheduled to start between 8 and 8:30 p.m. at local elementary schools, with high

school classes at all three schools set at 8 a.m.

Classes will be held at all schools except North High and Fern Elementary School, where construction work will be in progress. NHS classes will be at South High School, with students slated to be bussed to the SHS campus. No other students will be transported to school.

Fern students will attend classes at neighboring Greenwood School.

More than 800 eighth grade students have signed up for the six-week sessions. They will be

able to take a number of courses, including many for credit.
