Torrance Blvd Denker Work Slates in Shoestring Budget

An appropriation of \$25,000 has been provided in the 1959-60 Los Angeles City budget as a part payment of the proposed improvement of Denker St. and Torrance Blvd. in the strip area, announced Councilman John S. Gibson.

Three other Shoestring Strip projects also were provided for in the budget. Plans now are being prepared for the full improvement of the south side of Plaza Del Amo from Denker St. to Harvard Blvd., and for additional width between Harvard Blvd. and Western Ave. Construction funds will be sought next year.

Plans also are being prepared by harbor district engineers for the construction of curbs and gutters and paving of the shoulder on the east side of Western Ave. from 218th St. to Sepulveda Blvd. Construction funds for this job also will be sought in next year's budget.

Both Torrance Blvd. and Denker St. are included in the project now known as the 206th and Harvard Blvd. improvement district.

The current \$25,000 has been added to \$14,000 previously appropriated for this job.

Right-of-way acquisition across the railroad tracks at the intersection of Torrance Blvd.—Denker St.—208th St. resulted in this crossing being made a separate project. Funds for plans on this job also were provided.

Councilman Gibson said the \$386,600 allotted to his district in

the current budget would boost to more than \$1 million, available for construction during the fiscal year.

Previous years appropriations, plus partially financed projects of several years past, make up the difference.
