Symphony Orchestra to Play

Founder-conductor of the youth orchestra is Eugene Minor. He is a graduate of Narbonne High School and is now attending Los Angeles City College. He is a composer as well as clarinetist in the South Bay Youth Symphony.

The Harbor Youth Symphony has recently played on the aircraft carrier Kearsarge for Armed Forces Day. The orchestra has also had famous composers at its concerts such as Lowndes Maury, William Grant Still and Larry Willey.

Under Eugene Minors direction, the orchestra will be heard in Russian Sailor's Dance from the "Red Poppy" by Gliere; Ballet Egyptian by Luigini; Promenade and Great Gate from "Pictures at an Exhibition" by Mussorgsky; Little Hop Riding Hood by Forman; Blue Tango by Anderson; and other musical numbers.

The two soloists for the concert will be Alan Thomas Cerkick and Edward Pena. Alan Cerkick, who graduated from North High and now attending Monmouth College in Illinois, will be heard in the Horn Concerto No. 3 by Mozart. Edward Pena, Oboist for the South Bay Civic Symphony and assistant conductor of the orchestra, will play the Concerto for Oboe and Strings by Corelli.




