Grandma, 77, Keeps Busy with Art Work Weekend Jail for Printer

A sprightly old lady who paints for the fun of it, admits she would just as soon make her artistry pay. Mrs. Nettie Sandman, 77, of 2309 W. Carson St., who has been painting for a quarter of a century, has won awards in exhibits, but never made a dime.

"I think I would like a little recognition," she concedes, "and I could use some money."
Some of her paintings have wound up in homes of her four children, and many others of the approximately 100 she completed, were donated.

She has just completed two huge murals of ocean scenes, and right now is working on a desert scene.

Three Dimensions
"It's three-dimensional," she explains. "But still there is something missing, something to brighten it up."

Mrs. Sandman says that she has been compared to Grandma Moses, but she would just as soon settle for being known as Grandma Sandman. After all, she has six grandchildren and eight great grandchildren.

She started in art work about 25 years ago in Cleveland, when she painted silk and chiffon scarves for her children. Later her interest in painting broadened to canvas and she has been at it ever since.

A Torrance printer will have to spend his weekends in the County Jail for the next year.

Richard Vernon Florence, 34, who operates a printing plant at 1839 Torrance Blvd., was placed on three years probation Monday by Superior Judge Herbert Walker after pleading guilty to forgery charges.

Part of the probation terms call for the defendant to spend 52 weekends in jail, starting Aug. 22.

Florence, one of eight persons arrested when Los Angeles and Torrance detectives smashed an alleged \$12,000 check counterfeiting ring, was accused of printing the bogus checks.

Four of his co-defendants, all of whom have pleaded not guilty to the charge, face trial in Superior Court Aug. 18.

They include Robert Ives, 43, and Inez Moore Graham, 39, whose asserted boyfriend, Henry Thwaites of Torrance, is now on trial for the murder of the San Diego tavern owner.

The others are Evelyn Beers, 47, and Henry Ferrari. Police accused the asserted ring members of passing more than \$12,000 of forged checks at supermarkets throughout Los Angeles County.
