

Sewage Plant to Move to Palos Verdes Coast Site

The County Sanitation District has agreed to abandon the Royal Palms site at White Point in the San Pedro area for a sewage treatment plant, Supervisor Burton W. Chace and Los Angeles City Councilman John Gibson said today in a joint statement.

The plant, instead, will be constructed on county-owned property along the coastline, approximately one mile west of White Point and two and one-half miles west of Point Fermin.

The statement by Chace and Gibson pointed out that the sewage treatment plant will be built in such a manner as to be almost inconspicuous.

Check Bids for Alondra Park Community Building

Apparent low bid for the construction of a new community recreation building in the north-west section of Alondra park has been submitted by the H. W. Christensen Construction Company, Supervisor Kenneth Hahn announced today.

The five bids received on the project ranged from the apparent low of \$111,000 to a high of \$121,500.

Supervisor Hahn said that all bids are now being checked and analyzed and it is expected that the County Engineer will recommend award of contract to the Board and Supervisors within the next two weeks.

The Supervisor pointed out that Alondra is a regional county park and that the new recreation building will make possible greatly expanded and improved recreational facilities for the people of the large area which the park serves.

Plans, prepared by the architectural firm of O'Leary and Terasawa, call for construction of a building of nearly 5000 square feet which will be augmented by a large paved patio area or nearly 10,000 square feet.

Of modern design, combining both practicality and beauty, the recreation building will contain a large activity room, a meeting room, craft room, utility room, kitchen, office, and restrooms.

Supervisor Hahn stated that completion of the building will result in scheduling of regular recreational and leisure time programs at the facility, including hobbies and crafts, indoor games, physical education training classes and other activities. He said that the building will also be available for use of civic and community organizations, veterans, youth and other groups.

Peebles Asks Over-rule of Board's College Demand

Reversal of a recommendation that two years of college be required for applicants for the newly created post of his assistant, will be asked Tuesday by Wade E. Peebles, director of public works. He requested that a minimum two years of college requirement, suggested by the Civil Service Commission, be waived for candidates.

The commission recommended the two years of college following a previous examination which was passed by only one applicant. No college requirements were needed for the first test.

Peebles said that in a non-technical position, such as this, it is far more important to have experience than a college background.

"It is a known fact that in most fields of education, the first two years of college represent a student's general preparation, from which he advances into his desired technical field," Peebles maintained.

He said that in many cases where persons have two years of college, they frequently drop out because they either do not understand college work or because they cannot find a suitable field. Instead, Peebles recommended that an unasssembled exam be given for the post, which now is held on a temporary basis by Douglas J. Horlander.


