

School Bus Information Center Locations Announced

A special bus information center for the convenience of residents of this area whose children will be attending a Los Angeles City School will be opened starting September 1, it was announced by Raymond Nickerson, City Schools' transportation director.

The information center will be located at Fleming Junior High School.

The head driver will be available at the center for the two-week period preceding the September 14 opening date for the Los Angeles City Schools. However, the information center will be closed on Labor Day, Sept. 7, and Sept. 9. After school opens, all bus information will be given at each school, reports the Office of Public Information.

Information which the driver will give will relate to areas to be served, bus routes, time schedules, and other general school transportation problems.

He will be able to give information only on school bus transportation, Nickerson emphasized. Public transit line schedules and routes must be secured from the individual firms, he added.

Under Board of Education regulations, transportation is provided for all children who live two or more miles from their elementary school, two and one-half or more miles from their junior high school, and three or more miles from their senior high school.

Chest X-Ray Mobile Unit to Visit Torrance Area

County Health Department will move into the Torrance Health District August 24 and will be stationed at strategic locations for the following four weeks, announced Dr. B. A. Kogan, district health officer.

The schedule includes a stop in Gardena, where the x-ray unit will be stationed in front of the Veterans of Foreign Wars Building, 1822 162nd St., from 1 to 7 p.m. on August 24 and from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. on August 25.

Other locations include the Northeast corner of Berendo and Carson, across the street from the main entrance of Harbor General Hospital, August 26 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; August 27, 1 to 7 p.m.; downtown Torrance at 1401 Cabrillo Ave., August 28 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m.; August 31, 1 to 7 p.m.

On September 1 and 2 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., the truck will be stationed in the Pueblo district of Torrance at the San Jose Church, 2274 Del Amo Blvd.

Lomita residents will have the use of the x-ray truck's facilities on September 3 from 1 to 7 p.m. and September 4 from 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m. The truck will be stationed in front of the Hall's Five and Dime, 2200 Lomita Blvd.

The Southwood Shopping Center, Palos Verdes and Sepulveda Blvd., will be the next location for the mobile x-ray unit. September 8, 9 a.m. to 3:30 p.m., and September 10 from 1 to 7 p.m. are the schedules for this area. The unit will not be in operation September 9, Admission Day, a legal holiday.

The big green truck will complete its Torrance District schedule at the beach communities of Redondo Beach, Hermosa Beach, and Manhattan Beach.

As the chest x-ray unit has not been in this area for a year and medical authorities recommend that an x-ray be obtained at least once a year, Dr. Kogan is urging everyone over 15 years of age who has not had a chest x-ray recently to get one during the next few weeks.

"There is no charge for this tax-supported service," said Dr. Kogan, "reports are confidential; it takes but a minute and the x-ray is one of the methods used in detection of chest tumors and enlarged heart in addition to tuberculosis."
