Deny Request to Grade Private Lomita Street

A request by the Lomita Property Owners' Registered Voters, Inc., for grading and oiling of a private street between Oak St. and Narbonne Ave. has been denied. This was announced today by Supervisor Burton W. Chace, who pointed out that the Los Angeles County Road Department is not permitted to provide improvement of private streets. "Our investigation revealed that the private road not only serves as access to adjoining residences between Narbonne Ave. and Oak St., but also allows usage by through vehicular traffic," Chace said. "Under these conditions it would be advisable if adjoining property owners would stand the expense cooperatively of grading and oiling this private street."

Fiat St. Work Petition Started

Supervisor Burton W. Chace said today that the first step toward the eventual improvement of Fiat St. in Torrance has been taken. On the recommendation of Chace, the Board of Supervisors approved the circulation of a petition by residents of the area for the proposed formation of a special assessment district for the acquisition of rights of way and the improvement of Fiat St. Chace pointed out that in order for the Board to act by Aug. 1, 1960, when the petitions must be returned, it must be signed by owners of at least 60 per cent of the assessable area in the proposed district.
