





World War I Veterans to Install Slate

Art Hicks will be installed as first commander of the newly formed Torrance Barracks No. 1920 of the Veterans of World War I at ceremonies tomorrow at 8 p.m. in the Walteria Park recreation building.

Other officers to be installed are Paul Slonecker and Charles Blackburn, vice commanders; Pat Huffine, quartermaster; George Dannals, chaplain and Clarence Kaler and L. D. Stage, trustees.

Rile Eldredge, senior vice commander of the Department of California will be the installing officer, and Harry Buckles, national deputy chief-of-staff, will be master of ceremonies.

The Ladies Auxiliary will also be instituted at the meeting.

New Look Ordered at Libraries

Another try for the location of a regional library in the civic center will be studied by the Library Commission on suggestion of the City Council.

The board was given 45 days in which to make a recommendation.

At one time the county offered to construct a \$300,000 regional library here, but the city felt that the offer was tied to the city joining the county library district. The city presently contracts for library services with the county as a lower rate than it would cost to join the district.

Following a previous study the commission split on the question of whether to join the district or form municipal library system.

The new study is also designed to obtain figures on how the tax rate will be affected by joining the district.
